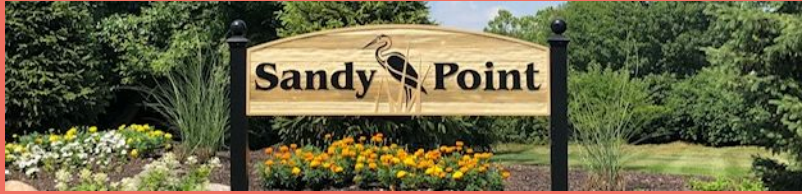

When and Where to Drop off Household Hazardous Waste

Marion County residents can dispose of unwanted and unused household hazardous waste (HHW) as well as electronics on Saturdays during

ToxDrop events. The regular times and the northside locations are listed below.

First Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM
Traders Point Collection Facility
7550 N. Lafayette Road

Indiana’s Electronic Waste law prohibits households from disposing of electronic waste in the trash. HHW is hazardous waste generated by households that is ignitable, toxic, reactive, corrosive, or otherwise poses a threat to human health or the environment. Careless management of HHW—such as pouring it down the drain, on the ground, into storm sewers, or putting it out with the regular trash—can create significant environmental and public health hazards.

You also can drop off electronics directly at RecycleForce's facility during the following hours:

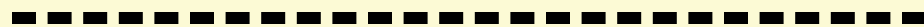

What can consumers dispose of at ToxDrop?

See the complete list of acceptable items on the city’s website at: <https://www.indy.gov/activity/hazardous-waste-dropoff-sites>. You can dispose of 20 gallons of liquid waste or 75 pounds of solid waste per visit. Transport it in plastic crates, cardboard boxes, storage bins, or in other containers that are easy to see through and access. Waste brought in trash bags may not be accepted. You can dispose of up to five computer systems per visit.

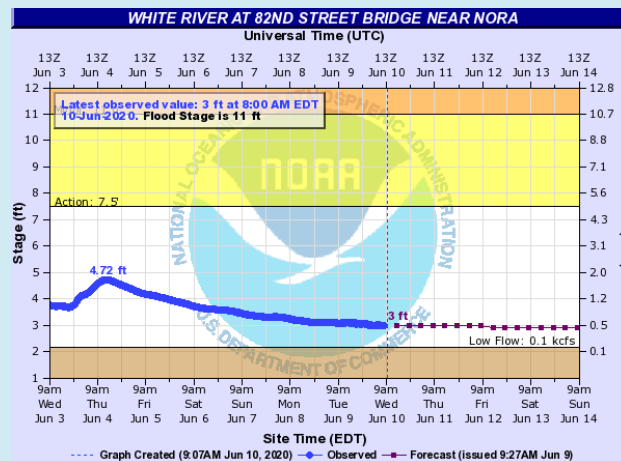
